RESOLUTION 2021-014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE, AND REVIEW BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE 2021 ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala maintains the public roadways, bridges, and infrastructure within the City; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala believes it is necessary and important to design and construct improvements to certain roadways in 2021 within the City; and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Director, the City Administration, and Council for the City of Pataskala want to complete improvements this year to the following: Clark State Road; Town Street; Columbia Road; and all roadways within the Summit Ridge Heights North Subdivision (2021 Roadway Improvements Program); and

WHEREAS, because the City of Pataskala reasonably estimates cost for 2021 Roadway Improvements Program will exceed \$50,000, it needs to seek competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2021 budget includes funding for these roadway improvements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator, or his designee, to advertise, receive, and review bids for the construction of the 2021 Roadway Improvements Program, as allowed and provided under Section 8.02 of the City Charter.

<u>Section 2:</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.
