A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO MAKE A PURCHASE NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF \$18,000.00 FOR TWO NEW POLICE DOGS.

WHEREAS, the Pataskala Police Department desires to purchase two new K9 dogs from Sculpadog located at Hoge Larenseweg 141 1221 AM Hilversum in the Netherlands that supply K9 dogs to police departments; and

WHEREAS, the Pataskala Police Department received donations for the purchase of the two new K9 dogs; and

WHEREAS, the two new K9 dogs will be beneficial not only to the City of Pataskala, but also to neighboring communities; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator requests authorization to make the purchase of the two new K9 dogs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Administrator is hereby authorized to make a purchase not to exceed the amount of eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000.00) for two new police dogs.

Section 2: This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
