A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WATCON ENGINEERS FOR THE DESIGN OF THE BOOSTER STATION PUMP IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Pataskala Utility Department provides drinking water for residents through the Water Treatment Plants; and

WHEREAS, the water is delivered to the customers through infrastructure in the form of pipe lines, towers, and pumps; and

WHEREAS, the recent growth and future growth potential warrants a study for pump improvements at the Water Booster Station; and

WHEREAS, the currents pumps need to be increased in size and flow rate to ensure sustainable water flow to current and future customers served by the booster station; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to design and gain Ohio EPA approval for the future purchase and installation of new pumps; and

WHEREAS, the department desires to contract with WatCon Engineers for the design of the Water Booster Station Pump Improvement Design Project in an amount not to exceed eighteen thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$18,750); and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase is available under the 2015 Water Engineering Budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with WatCon Engineers for the design of the Water Booster Station Pump Improvement Design Project in an amount not to exceed eighteen thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$18,750)

<u>Section 2:</u> This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
