A RESOLUTION TO CONFIRM THE LOCATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW POLICE STATION BEHIND THE PATASKALA CITY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala plans to construct a new police station facility; and

WHEREAS, all property currently owned by the City of Pataskala has been reviewed to determine the best location for the construction of a new police station facility; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the best location to construct a new police station facility is behind the City Administration Building located at 621 West Broad Street.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The Pataskala City Council confirms the location for the construction of a new police station facility is behind the City Administration Building located at 621 West Broad Street.

<u>Section 2:</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: his Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of

Pataskala.
