- **Pool Concession Operations** 
  - Swim Instructor Job Description: **ORDINANCE 2022-4412** 
    - This is an ordinance to create a swim lesson instructor position within the parks and recreation department. The parks department would like to amend the original job description by substitution. The new description now will be called Swim Instructor/Guest Services Team Member. The role of this position is a hybrid of 3 separate duties. 1. Swim Instructor (60%) 2. Concessions (30%) and 3. Guest services (10%). The proposed changes are not drastically different but does allow for applicants who apply to be a swim instructor to also be offered additional hours working in the concession stand.
  - The Parks and Recreation Department is currently still weighing our options for the concession stand operations for our aquatic's facility. As mentioned previously this service is valuable to our operations and we want to ensure we have covered all options prior to making a final decision. In the meantime, at the second reading for the supplemental the parks department is asking council for funds to cover expenses that could accrue with adding the concessions to our operations this summer. The options that we are considering will come with an expense, so we are asking council to approve this amount to ensure we have the spending authority ahead of time. The Parks Advisory Board is against the parks department operating the concession stand this year. We are still taking applications for aquatic positions which will drive our decisions heavily come March of 2022. The Parks Manager is actively recruiting

## **Ordinance 2022-4416: Creating New Aquatic Facility Concession Stand positions**

This is an ordinance to create 2 new positions within the parks and recreation department. We are seeking to add Concession Stand Worker and an Assistant Concessions Manager. The Pataskala Municipal Pool has been offering concessions for the patrons for many years and we would like to have this option in the future as we prepare to fully take over. The recreation department now would like to create official positions to solely operate this aspect of the Aquatic Division. The positions are not funded in the 2022 budget cycle
