A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE, AND REVIEW BIDS FOR NECESSARY REPAIRS TO IRON FILTER TWO AT WATER TREATMENT PLANT ONE

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala operates and maintains a drinking water treatment plant located at 7024 Hazleton-Etna Road (Water Treatment Plant One); and

WHEREAS, iron filter tanks are a critical component of the treatment process; and

WHEREAS, one of the three iron filter tanks at Water Treatment Plant One has a leak somewhere along the bottom of the tank; and

WHEREAS, to diagnose the leak, all of the iron filter media must be removed and eventually replaced after the repair is made; and

WHEREAS, because the City of Pataskala reasonably believes the cost for the iron filter repairs will exceed \$50,000, it needs to seek competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, the funds for this project are encompassed in the 2022 budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:
