RESOLUTION 2022-042

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PRIME CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND SURVEY TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE 2022 ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala maintains and improves the public roadways; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala is beginning the formal bidding process for the 2022 Roadway Improvements Program; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala wants to make certain the 2022 Roadway Improvements Program is built in compliance with the approved plans and specifications. In order to accomplish this important goal, Council for the City of Pataskala wants to enter into a contract with Prime Construction Management and Survey to provide construction administration and inspection services – services the City cannot provide in-house; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala reasonably believes these construction administration and inspection services will cost no more than Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and// No Cents (\$35,000.00). Funding for this contract will be provided from the Street Fund (201).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract, in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$35,000.00), with Prime Construction Management and Survey for construction administration and inspection services of the 2022 Roadway Improvements Program.

<u>Section 2</u>: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
