A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH VERDANTAS, LLC FOR CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE POPLAR STREET TWO-INCH WATERLINE UPGRADE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Utility Department operates and maintains a drinking water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, the waterline in the Poplar Street area has been identified for an upgrade that will be constructed in 2022; and

WHEREAS, knowing the cost for inspection services would not trigger the competitive bidding threshold, the Utility Department utilized the qualification packets submitted as a part of the city wide RFQ process to select a firm for construction inspection services; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Department reviewed the material submitted by interested firms and ranked Verdantas as the number one, preferred firm; and

WHEREAS, the Utility Department then engaged in scope and cost negotiations with Verdantas LLC. which resulted in a desirable agreement for inspection services; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract with Verdantas, LLC for construction inspection services for the Poplar Street Two-Inch Waterline Upgrade Project, with the total contract amount not to exceed \$36,000.00.
