## CITY OF PATASKALA

## **ORDINANCE 2016-4269**

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016

*WHEREAS*, Council previously adopted the Municipal Budget for the year ending December 31, 2016, and is authorized to amend the budget during the budget year; and

**WHEREAS**, the city's Police department is in need of replacing certain law enforcement-related equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the Law Enforcement Trust (212) fund is a special revenue fund that is specifically restricted to the purchase of law enforcement equipment, officer training, and officer overtime in certain cases; and

WHEREAS, the original operating budget (Ord. 2015-4243), did not include sufficient appropriations from the Law Enforcement Trust fund for this purpose; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 5.04 of Article V of the Charter of the City of Pataskala, the Finance Department has determined that it is necessary to make certain amendments to the 2016 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(B) provides, in part, that no subdivision or taxing unit shall "make any expenditure of money unless it has been appropriated in such chapter."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> City Council hereby authorizes an increase in the appropriations in the Police function, General Operating object in the amount of **five thousand dollars** (\$5,000.00) in the **Law Enforcement Trust Fund** (**Fund 202**) to pay the expenses associated with the purchase of certain law enforcement-related equipment, as follows:

<u>Section 3:</u> This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
