RESOLUTION 2016-033

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE A NEW COMPUTER SERVER FOR USE BY THE PATASKALA POLICE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Police Department utilizes a centralized server for storage of files and videos; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala's current computer server is aged and running outdated software; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Police Department has determined it necessary to purchase a new computer server to provide more secure file and video storage capabilities. The purchase price of new server does not exceed the threshold limit to require competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala now wants to authorize the City Administrator to purchase a new computer server for the Police Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to purchase a new computer server from Jon E. Udischas for use by the Pataskala Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$22,000.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
