

CITY OF PATASKALA ORDINANCE 2015-4214

Passed March 2, 2015

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2015.

WHEREAS, Council is authorized to adopt and amend the Municipal Budget, for the year ending December 31, 2015, which was originally authorized by Council through Ordinance 2014-4207; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator desires to enter into a contract for the purchase and installation of a salt storage building, and the original operating budget did not include sufficient appropriations from the Street (201) fund for this purpose; and

WHEREAS, additional budget reclassifications, increases and decreases to the original operating budget have been requested; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.04 of Article V of the Charter of the City of Pataskala, the Finance Department has determined that it is necessary to make certain amendments to the 2014 budget; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(B) provides, in part, that no subdivision or taxing unit shall "make any expenditure of money unless it has been appropriated in such chapter."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO; A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> City Council hereby authorizes an increase in the appropriations in the Public Service function, Capital Outlay object in the amount of **one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000.00)** from the **Street Fund (Fund 201)** to pay the expenses associated with the purchase and installation of a salt storage facility, as follows:
