Proposed Motions to Enter Executive Session

1. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 121.22(G)(1), I move that we enter into an executive session:

To consider the appointment, employment, dismissal, discipline, promotion, demotion, or compensation of a public employee or official, or the investigation of charges or complaints against a public employee, official, licensee, or regulated individual, unless the public employee, official, licensee, or regulated individual requests a public hearing.

2. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 121.22(G)(2), I move that we enter into an executive session:

To consider the purchase of property for public purposes, or for the sale of property at competitive bidding, if premature disclosure of information would give an unfair competitive or bargaining advantage to a person whose personal, private interest is adverse to the general public interest.

3. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 121.22(G)(3), I move that we enter into an executive session:

A conference with an attorney, for the public body, concerning disputes involving the public body that are the subject of pending or imminent court action.

4. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 121.22(G)(4), I move that we enter into an executive session:

Preparing for, conducting, or reviewing negotiations or bargaining sessions with public employees concerning their compensation or other terms and conditions of their employment.

5. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(5), I move that we enter into an executive session:

To discuss matters that federal law, federal rules, or state statutes require the public body to keep confidential.

6. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(6), I move that we enter into an executive session:

To discuss details of security arrangements and emergency response protocols for a public body or public office, if disclosure of the matters discussed could reasonably be expected to jeopardize the security of the public body or public office.

7. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(7), I move that we enter into an executive session:

To discuss trade secrets of a county hospital, a joint township hospital, or a municipal hospital.

8. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(8), I move that we enter into an executive session:

To protect the interests of the applicant or the possible investment or expenditure of public funds to be made in connection with the economic development project.

9. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22(G)(9), I move that we enter into an executive session:

To consider an applicant's request for financial assistance, unless the applicant requests a public hearing.
