ORDINANCE 2015-4210

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT TO PURCHASE A NEW 1-TON DUMP TRUCK THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COMPETITIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND TO ENTER INTO A CAPITAL LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF THIS TRUCK.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala has a continuing duty to the public to provide efficient and effective service delivery to the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala has determined it necessary to purchase a new 1-ton dump truck for use by the Public Services Department.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala budgeted for the financing of these trucks as part of the 2015 budget.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION ONE. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a capital lease agreement for the procurement of a new 1-ton dump truck for use by the City's Public Service Department.

SECTION TWO. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into contract for the procurement of a new 1-ton dump truck for use by the City's Public Service Department, through the State of Ohio Competitive Purchasing Program in an amount not to exceed \$60,000

<u>SECTION THREE</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time provided by the laws of the State of Ohio and the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
