Current Projects & Issues

Planning and Zoning Commission:

December 7, 2016 Hearing: The following applications are scheduled to be heard at the December 7, 2016 Planning and Zoning Commission hearing:

- Application ZON-16-008: Michael Scharfenberger is requesting to rezone properties from the PRO – Professional Research Office and R-20 – Medium Density Residential to PRO – Professional Research Office pursuant to Section 1217.10 of the Pataskala Code.
- <u>Application ZON-16-006</u>: Westport Homes Inc. is requesting approval of a final plan pursuant to Section 1255.14(d) of the Pataskala Code.

January 4, 2017 Hearing: Currently no applications have been submitted for the January 4, 2017 Planning and Zoning Commission hearing. The application deadline is December 9, 2016.

Board of Zoning Appeals

December 13, 2016 Hearing: The following applications are scheduled to be heard at the December 13, 2016 Board of Zoning Appeals hearing:

- Application CU-16-010: Rosemary Morgan Trust is requesting a conditional use pursuant to Section 1249.04(14) of the Pataskala Code to allow the property to be used for a mini-storage facility for the property located at 7095 Summit Road.
- <u>Application VA-16-029</u>: C. Daniel Hayes is requesting a variance from Section 1221.05(D)(1) of the Pataskala Code to allow an accessory building to be located in the front yard for the property located at 377 South Main Street.
- Application VA-16-030: Robert Platte is requesting a variance from Section 1229.05(C)(2) of the Pataskala Code to allow for the construction of a single-family dwelling that would fail to meet the required side yard setback for the property located at 353 Woodside Drive SW.

January 10, 2017 Hearing: Currently no applications have been submitted for the January 10, 2017 Board of Zoning Appeals hearing. The application deadline is December 16, 2016.

> International Manufacturing Technology Show

- I attended the International Manufacturing Technology Show in Chicago from September 11 to September 15 with a group from GROW Licking County.
- City Council requested an update on the follow up undertaken since our return. A summary prepared in consultation with Grow Licking County is as follows:
 - Eight total meetings with businesses looking to expand into the US/Columbus/Central Ohio market
 - Two of these businesses have expressed interest in meeting/scheduling opportunities for mid-2017 (working through JobsOhio/Columbus 2020)
 - One of these businesses have expressed interest in meeting/scheduling opportunities in early 2017 (working through JobsOhio/Columbus 2020)
 - The balance is in continued discussions directly with Columbus 2020 -but nothing firm
 - Our meetings with the German American Chamber of Commerce have enabled conversations to begin with COTC, CTEC, & Workenomics to review and identify pathways for a proposed apprenticeship program.
 - This is a priority for GLC & 2020 -- and I believe Licking County will be the test case for this type of initiative.
 - I have spoken with COTC & CTEC representatives (Lauren Massie & Vicki Maple traveled to Chicago for a day in/day out tour of Harper College) -and following discussions at our Manufacturers Council meetings, I believe this will be moving forward in 2017.
 - Mario (GACC) has offered to travel to Licking County to meet with community leaders to discuss the benefits of this initiative (so watch your e-mails for future opportunities)
 - Due to our meeting with Earnst & Young, GLC has established a local relationship with their team in Columbus -- and we correspond regularly.
 - Our final meeting with ROI has resulted in GROW Licking County moving forward with a contract to them (following solicitation of two other firms) to begin a county-wide industry analysis and subsequent lead-generation proposal.
 - The GLC Board of Directors moved on this contract at the last Board meeting and we are hoping to begin the analysis before the end of the year.
