Request:	Requesting a variance from Section 1221.05(B)(1) of the Pataskala Code to
	allow for an accessory building that would exceed the maximum permitted size.

Description of the Request:

The applicant is seeking a variance to allow for an Accessory Building permit to be issued for a 10' x 14' (140-square feet) shed which fails to meet the maximum permitted accessory building size.

Staff Summary:

The property currently contains a 1,216-square foot home in the Northeast corner that was constructed in 1900, and a 675-square foot garage in the Southwest corner that was built in 1960. The applicant has constructed a 140-square foot shed next to the existing 675-square foot garage for a total of 815-square feet. Section 1121.05(B)(1) of the Pataskala Code limits the maximum square footage for accessory buildings on lots less than 2 acres in size. This is determined by the following formula:

((Gross acreage of lot) x 600) + 120) x 2

The applicant's lot is 0.13 acres in size, using the equation $((0.13) \times 600) + 120) \times 2 = 396$ -square feet. The shed and garage exceed the maximum permitted square footage by 419-square feet, or by 49%. The site plan as submitted does not include a distance to the south property line, however, according to the application and narrative, the applicant has built a roof on top of the fence that was previously approved. This fence is on the applicant's property line, which gives the shed a setback of 0 feet.

The applicant also stated in the narrative that the purpose of the shed is to serve as a shelter for his Great Danes.

The applicant had initially constructed a fence and was cited for not obtaining a Fence Permit by the Zoning Inspector. After a court summons and order was issued, the fence permit was applied for. During the final inspection of the fence, the Zoning Inspector discovered a shed was also built. The Zoning Inspector informed the applicant that an Accessory Building Permit was required for the shed. The applicant did not take any action towards applying for a permit and was issued a court summons and

order again. When the applicant submitted the Accessory Building Permit Application, staff determined that the shed exceeded the maximum permitted square footage for accessory buildings, and a variance would be required. When no variance application was submitted, the applicant was again issued a court summons and an order.

Staff Review: The following review does not constitute recommendations but merely conclusions and suggestions from the summary.

In addition to the requested variance, staff has identified a need for a side yard setback variance. The constructed shed sits even with the fence, which was built on the property line. Section 1221.05(E)(1) requires a 5-foot setback of accessory buildings from property lines on lots less than two acres. The Board of Zoning Appeals may choose to grant this variance along with the requested variance in this application. In this case, the variance request will be for the full 5 feet, with a side yard setback of 0 feet.

When staff visited the property to photograph the shed for the purposes of this variance on September 26, a man performing electrical work in the shed and garage confirmed that the shed was built for housing the dogs. This gentleman also stated that there is a pass-through built into the shed and garage to allow for the dogs to go in between the two structures, and that he estimates there to be approximately a dozen dogs housed on the property. Staff witnessed five dogs in the enclosed yard and were told by the man present on the property that these were the puppies, and that the two parents were inside the structure, for a total of at least seven dogs.

Online inquiries by the Zoning Inspector have supplied several online advertisements for Great Dane puppies. The first, posted on February 22, 2018 lists the applicant's phone number and was posted under the username "danesrrfarms". As of October 1, 2018, there were 6 puppies for sale under the username "danesrrfarms". Also included are 10 violations from the Licking County Dog Warden for failure to register dogs. 4 violations on March 31, 2017, 4 violations on October 12, 2017, and 2 violations on October 13, 2017. Each violation constitutes an offense for a separate dog. The Zoning Inspector has also commented on several previous, and current code violations. Full comments are attached.

Section 1203.03 defines a Kennel (Private) as "Any lot or premises on which five or more domesticated dogs or cats, of more than four months of age, are housed, groomed, bred, boarded, trained, or sold". The online advertisements, citations from the Licking County Dog Warden, and information provided to staff during the visit to the property gives staff reason to believe a kennel is being operated on the premises. Kennels are neither a permitted or conditional use within the R-7 Zoning District pursuant to Sections 1237.03 and 1237.04 of the Pataskala Code.

The Licking County Building Code Department requires a building permit for any new structure or addition that is attached to an existing structure. The applicant did not state in the variance application whether the constructed shed is attached to the existing garage, however from the photographs taken of the shed on 9/26/2018 and the statement of the man performing electrical work in the shed, staff believes that the shed is attached to the existing garage. Staff contacted the Licking County Building Code Department, and they have received no building permit applications for 21 Benton St.

Paula Evans and Brady Fortney, of the Licking County Humane Society (LCHS) contacted Mr. Collins at the 21 Benton Street address on October 2, 2018. In a summary of their visit sent to Staff they described seeing 11 dogs; 4 adults, 2 young adults, and 5 puppies. There was another dog in the house which Mr. Collins' claimed was his daughters. LCHS Humane Agents raised concerns over 2 of the dogs having a condition known as "cherry eye", as well as concerns over unsanitary and hazardous conditions for the dogs in the garage and enclosed area. LCHS required through notice to Mr. Collins to address the cherry eye on 2 of the Great Danes within 24 to 48 hours, clean up the fence area, and be put on a re-check list to verify items have been corrected. Full comments from LCHS are attached.

Also Present during this visit was Licking County Animal Shelter Deputy Tyler Moore, who questioned Mr. Collins on the licensing of the dogs. Mr. Collins stated he had purchased 2 tags. Deputy Moore made a list of the dogs present and stated he would be sending Mr. Collins a citation for the remaining unlicensed dogs.

Paula Evans followed-up with staff via a phone call on October 8, 2018. She stated Mr. Collins said he plans to sell the 2 dogs with cherry eye, however he would be taking them to a vet for surgery prior to doing so. Ms. Evans told Mr. Collins that he will have to inform LCHS Agents where the appointment will be taking place. She also stated that should Mr. Collins choose to surrender some of the dogs, he will have to surrender them to LCHS.

On October 8, 2018, Zoning Inspector Steven Blake visited the property and observed at least 2 dogs loose from their enclosure. One on Benton Street, and the other on Jefferson Street.

The City of Pataskala Police Department has provided additional documents pertaining to issues with dogs. In 2016 there were 2 incidents of Dogs at Large. 4 incidents in 2017, and 3 incidents so far in 2018, that the Pataskala Police Department has responded to.

Staff followed up with the Licking County Dog Warden on December 3, 2018. As of that date the applicant has not obtained licenses for 9 of the dogs present at the property.

Also included is a comment from a neighbor received by staff via email on October 9, 2018. Please see the minutes for additional neighbor comments from the previous hearing on November 13, 2018.

Variance Requirements:

According to Section 1211.07(1) of the Pataskala Code, the Board of Zoning appeals shall consider the following factors when determining if an area variance is warranted:

- a) Whether the property in question will yield a reasonable return or if there can be a beneficial use of the property;
- b) Whether there are unique physical circumstances or conditions that prohibit the property being developed in strict conformity with the zoning regulation such that a variance is necessary to enable the reasonable use of the property;
- c) Whether the variance requested is substantial;
- d) Whether the essential character of the neighborhood would be substantially altered or the adjoining properties would suffer a substantial detriment as a result of the variance;
- *e)* Whether the variance, if granted, will substantially or permanently impair the appropriate use or development of adjacent property;
- *f)* Whether the variance, if granted, will be detrimental to the public welfare;
- g) Whether the variance, if granted, would adversely affect the delivery of government services;
- *h)* Whether the property owner purchased the subject property with knowledge of the zoning restriction;
- *i)* Whether the property owner's predicament con be obviated through some other method than variance;
- *j)* Whether the variance, if granted, will represent the minimum variance that will afford relief and represent the least modification possible of the requirement at issue; and,
- *k*) Whether the spirit and intent behind the zoning requirement would be observed and substantial justice done by granting the variance.





Zoning Inspector Summary

During the inspection of the fence in February 2018, I observed the Accessory Building on the property which a variance request is now before the board. There was no permit for the Accessory Building at the time of my inspection. A Court summons and order was required to have Mr. Collins comply with Accessory Building permit requirement.

Mr. Collins had also failed to apply for the required permits on the fence on his property in April 2017 and a Court summons and order was also required to have Mr. Collins comply with Fence permit requirement.

Area neighbors have complained concerning Mr. Collins failure to maintain his property, contain his dogs, the dogs defecating on neighboring properties and the safety concerns for residents, especially elderly and children with these dogs running loose. These dogs are Great Danes weighing from 100 to up to 200 pounds.

- Pataskala Police cited Mr. Collins on 2-24-2017 for dogs running at large.
- Licking County Dog Warden cited Mr. Collins Failure to confine dogs on 3 separate occasions in late 2017 including 10 violations for Failure to Register Dogs. (see attached documents)

Mr. Collins stated during my fence inspection the shed was built for his dogs. On line inquiries indicate recent puppy sales by danesrrfarms associated with Mr. Collins by evidence of Mr. Collins phone number being listed. (see attached documents). 21 Benton street is in the R-7 Zoning and Dog Kennels are not a permitted use.

Recent complaints include:

- 9-24-2018 Area church on dogs running loose, safety of church members, especially elderly and children. Dogs defecating on parking lot. Trash on his property.
- 8-20-2018 Trash, vehicles on property and dogs running loose and dogs using neighboring properties as "dumping grounds" daily.
- 6-25-2018 complaint on trash, dogs running loose, 3-4 adult dogs plus puppies on property.
- 4-9-2018 Neighbor complaint regarding dogs and trash.
- 3-28-2018 Trash, dogs loose and odor.

As of 9-27-2018 warning notices were sent to Mr. Collins regarding 3 current Code Violations: Trash, Inoperable vehicles (5 total) and Commercial Vehicle Parked in Residential

Since 2016 to present, Mr. Collins has had 9 cases in Pataskala Mayor's Court including 4 which involved failure to obtain the required zoning permits after being notified.

A total 32 pre-summons notifications and 13 Mayor's Court Summons have been issued to Mr. Collins since 2016 to present.

A complaint was received concerning the living conditions and medical concerns relating to 12 dogs located at 21 Benton St., Pataskala, OH 43062 which are approximately 12 Great Danes on the property. There are adults and puppies. Concerns raised were the unsanitary and hazardous conditions and several of the dogs show having signs of cherry eye.

Contact was made with Mr. Collins on October 2, 2018. I, Brady Fortney (LCHS Staff/Humane Agent in Training) and Deputy Tyler Moore, Licking County Animal Shelter were on the scene. When we first arrived we made contact with Mr. Collins son and he stated his dad was in the garage. I was able to observe 5 puppies, 2 younger adult Great Danes in a fenced area that was covered in debris. You could also smell a strong odor of feces. Mr. Collins came out and was not receptive that we were there and voiced his concern that this was being driven by the zoning department. I explained I was there to look at the living conditions and how the dogs were being housed and that there were also complaints that some dogs showed visible signs of cherry eye.

Finally after the arrival of Pataskala Police Department Mr. Collins gave us permission to enter the property. He was asked multiple times that he was in agreement for us to enter and observe the dogs. He stated yes. He allowed me and Deputy Moore to enter. Upon entering the following was observed.

- 4 adult dogs were in the garage/mechanic area of the garage and blocked off into one area. This area is used as a workshop so there are a lot of tools, equipment, chemicals and items related to operating a workshop. The area the 4 dogs were in had a lot of stuff and these were 4 large great danes. One dog displayed a swollen eye from possible eye entropia.
- The attached area had a "man cave" room with furniture in it and off of it was another area that he had wooden kennels set up that were made of wood that lead out into the back yard area.

We proceeded outside and I stood on the chair and was able to observe the fenced area in the back which had multiple areas of debris. It ranged from furniture, wood pile, pallets, doors windows, metal roofing material (which was in an area where a dog could be seriously injured), plus a trash pile and other odds and ends of debris. I noticed 2 younger adult black great danes that both showed signs of extreme cherry eye. There were also 5 puppies running around. The 2 younger adult danes were trying to get into the trash that Mr. Collins son had just put over the fence. Mr. Collins stated that the area was a mess because he had to move pallets into the fenced area and the unsanitary and hazardous conditions had just happened over the last few days.

I went over the concerns about the amount of hazardous items in the fenced area that could be harmful to the dogs being out in the area. In addition, concerns relating to the medical regarding the cherry eye on 2 of the dogs. Mr. Collins was not the easiest person to deal with on the situation. He was questioned on licensing of the dogs by Deputy Moore and stated that he purchased 2 tags for 2018. A list of dogs was made by Deputy Moore and he would be sending Mr. Collins a citation for the remaining dogs. Dogs identified were 4 adults, 2 adult males 11 months old and 5 puppies approximately 12 to 14

weeks old. There was another dog in the house that he would not show us that he stated belonged to his daughter.

Mr. Collins was not willing at times to continue the conversation to get things resolved so the following requirements were put in place by giving Mr. Collins Notice:

- 1. He is required to get the 2 black great danes into a veterinarian within 24 to 48 hours regarding the cherry eye.
- 2. He needed to clean up the fence in area to eliminate the hazardous environment and clean up the unsanitary conditions.
- 3. He would also be put on a recheck list to verify the items had been corrected.

At this point Mr. Collins stated we were done and we left the property.



NARRATIVE **INVESTIGATOR NOTE:**

On September 7, 2018 at 12:37 PM I was dispatched to 21 Benton St. Pataskala Ohio, 43062 to take a report in reference to an assault.

Upon my arrival I met with the victim, Paul Collins who was bleeding from his left hand and the laceration appeared to me to need stitches however Mr. Collins denied medical treatment and chose to wrap his hand. Mr. Collins stated one of his employee, Mark Brown keeps accusing the other workers of sleeping with his girlfriend and today Mark called him and stated he lied and was covering for one of the employees. Mr. Collins stated Mark showed up at his house and had a crow bar and smashed a bird house and then went to swing at him and he blocked the hit with his left hand and that is when it got cut. At this time another employee, Mark Ramirez stepped in and was able to get the crow bar away from him and took Mark Brown to the ground to try and restrain him. Both Mr. Collins and Mr. Ramirez stated when they were trying to restrain Mr. Brown they both threw strikes to defend themselves. After letting Mr. Brown up both stated he pulled a knife on them and they backed off and Mr. Brown started to walk away and told them he would be back with his gun.

I had Mr. Collins and Mr. Ramirez fill out written statements and their statements were consistent and Mr. Collins stated he was unsure of how he wanted to proceed from this point. Mr. Collins stated he does not necessarily want Mr. Brown to go to jail but stated he is ex-military and with the recent loss of his son and father he now has severe anger issues but didn't want Mr. Brown to come back to his property. I advised Mr. Collins I would take the report and call Mr. Brown and advise him not to return to the property and then he could let me know if he wanted to pursue charges after he thought about it. I then took pictures of Mr. Collins' hand and a scratch on his shoulder and asked again if he wanted a medic and he denied it once again.

After clearing the scene I called Mr. Brown and asked him what happened earlier and he stated it was just a misunderstanding about a girl. I asked Mr. Brown if he hit Mr. Collins with a crow bar and he denied it and stated they had a little tussle and during the tussle Mr. Collins stuck his thumb into his eye ball and was on the way to the hospital because he couldn't see out of it. I then advsied Mr. Brown not to return to Mr. Collin's property.

NARRATIVE **INVESTIGATOR NOTE:**

On the above listed date I was on routine patrol in my marked cruiser stationary on SR 310 near Mill Street. I ran the Ohio license plate number, GEY6319, of a northbound vehicle. When the vehicle passed me I noticed that the rear Ohio license plate number, FGH5662, was different from the front plate number. I caught up to the vehicle and activated my overhead lights as it turned eastbound onto Benton Street. The vehicle, a white 1998 Pontiac Bonnivlle, pulled over and parked at 21 Benton Street. The rear license plate, FGH5662, came back to a 2012 GMC SW whose owner is Pual Collins who lives at 21 Benton Street. That license plate did not have a valid registration tag on it but came back as being valid. The front license plate, GEY6319, came back to a 1998 Pontiac Bonniville whose owner is Angela Rice. That license plate did not come back as stolen and the registration expired on 3-25-17.

I spoke with the driver, Jerry Crutchfield II, who stated that he was working on the vehicle for Mr. Collins. He stated that Mr. Collins told him to drop it off at the house and that he would meet him there. I asked him for his drivers license and he said that he did not have it on him. I asked him if he was valid and he stated that he was not valid. I ran his social security number through dispatch and they advised me that he had a valid warrant out of Reynoldsburg. I placed Mr. Crutchfield under arrest and searched him incident to arrest. Dispatch got into contact with Reynoldsburg and they stated that they wanted him. I issued Mr. Crutchfield a citation for driving under a non compliance suspension. advised him of his mandatory court date, transported him to the COTC parking lot, and exchanged custody with Reynoldsburg with no incident.

I gave Mr. Colllins a courtesy call instead of impounding the vehicle. He did not answer so I left a message stating to get back with me ASAP so I would not impound the vehicle. Mr. Collins called me a little later and stated that he did not tell Mr. Crutchfield to drive the vehicle to his house and that he bout the vehicle from Angela Rice. He said Mr. Crutchfield also was working on another one of his vehicles that matched the description of the GMC the rear license plate number came back to. Mr. Collins said that he had the title but would not be back till Monday. I advised him that I would not impound the vehicle and that he cannot drive it until the license plate infractions were corrected. Mr. Collins advised me that he would remove all license plates and have it towed. He also stated that he did not want to press additional charges on Mr. Crutchfield.

NARRATIVE INVESTIGATOR NOTE:

On 07/10/2017 at approx 0110 hours, I observed a red pickup truck traveling north on Main Street near George Street,. I pulled up behind the truck and as I entered the Ohio license plate number that was displayed on the rear of the truck into my BMV computer, (Oh tag HCG9949) the truck turned onto Benton Street and pulled into a parking spot at a church. The driver got out of the truck and walked up to a house across from the church. I drove around the block and parked in an alleyway to see if the truck was going to leave a short time later. Approx. 15 minutes later, the truck then left and traveled south on Jefferson Street. I began to follow the truck and noticed that the truck did not have a white light illuminating the rear license plate. The truck then turned west on to Mill Street without using a turn signal to indicate the turn. The truck was stopped for said violations.

I advised dispatch of the traffic stop and gave them the tag # and location of the stop. Dispatch confirmed the tag # and advised that the truck was reported stolen. The driver opened the drivers side door and I told him to close the door. I then approached the drivers side and opened the door and had the driver, John Roshon exit the vehicle and placed him in handcuffs. I advised him that he was being detained. I patted him down for weapons and placed him in the rear of my cruiser. It was verified through dispatch / LEADS the the vehicle was stolen. I read Mr. Roshon his constitutional rights and asked him if he wanted to answer any questions. He said sure. I asked him where he got the truck from tonight and he said he got the truck from a guy named " Brian" but had no idea what Brians last name was. Mr. Roshon said that he was to come over to the house that he just left to get \$10 and return back to where he came from in Reynoldsburg. Mr. Roshon was placed under arrest for the listed charge and upon completion of the paperwork, he was transported to the Licking County Justice Center and slated on the listed charge,

It should be noted that the truck was reported stolen through the Columbus Police Department (Report # 170506697-004). A copy of that report is included in this report. It should also be noted that while en route to the jail, Sgt. Mcgeorge advised that the vehicle owner arrived at our station. I contacted him by phone and he said that she did not know Mr. Roshon and he did not have permission to have the truck. After leaving the jail and returning to our station, it was found that the owner Barbera Romans was now saying that her boyfriend / ex boyfriend had given Mr. Roshon permission to drive the truck. She completed a statement and a copy of that statement is included in this report.



SPOKE WITH TOMMY LEE IN REGARDS TO DOGS CHASING HIS KID THE NIGHT PRIOR. THE DOGS BELONGED TO A TENANT ACROSS THE STREET, PAUL COLLINS. MR. LEE STATED THE DOGS ARE ALWAYS OFF THEIR LEASHES, AND GO ONTO HIS PROPERTY. MR. LEE STATED HE HAD WORDS WITH MR. COLLINS ABOUT THE ISSUE, BUT NO DIRECT THREATS WERE MADE. I THEN SPOKE WITH MR. COLLINS AT 21 BENTON ST., AND ADVISED HIM OF THE COMPLAINT. I EXPLAINED TO HIM OUR ORDINANCE, AND SUGGESTED THAT IT WOULD PROBABLY BE BEST TO ALWAYS HAVE HIS DOGS ON LEASHES WHEN THEY ARE OUTSIDE BECAUSE OF HIS UNIQUE RESIDENCE SITUATION AT THE TIME BEING. MR. COLLINS STATED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD. HE WAS TOLD THAT HE WOULD PROBABLY BE CITED IF ANOTHER COMPLAINT WAS FIELDED REGARDING HIS DOGS. IT WAS MR. COLLINS BELIEF THAT THE COMPLAINT STEMS FROM A PAST CIVIL ISSUE BETWEEN HE AND MR. LEE.
