



CITY OF PATASKALA

COUNCIL MEETING

May 21, 2018

The Council of the City of Pataskala met in regular session on May 21, 2018 at 7:00 PM in City Hall, located at 621 W. Broad Street. The pledge of allegiance was given. Roll Call: Barstow, Hayes, Hickin, and Lee-present, Carter, Walther, and Powell -absent. Mayor Michael W. Compton presiding and Brian Zets, Law Director was present.

Citizens Comments

Introduction, discussion and approval of Consent Agenda matters

Barstow made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Seconded by Hickin. Roll Call: Barstow, Hayes, Hickin, and Lee-yes. Mayor Compton declared the Consent Agenda passed.

The Consent Agenda included the Administrator's Report, Department Reports and the minutes from the May 7, 2018 Council Public Hearing 6:30 PM, May 7, 2018 Council Public Hearing 6:45 PM, and May 7, 2018 Council Meeting.

Reports

Mayor Compton gave an update on the upcoming Memorial Day celebration.

BJ King, City Administrator gave an update on the relocation of the Finance Department and HR interviews.

James Nicholson, Finance Director gave an update on the move as well as an Achievement Award that was received at the Safety Meeting.

Nathan Coey, Utility Director gave an update on projects and accepted questions from Council.

Alan Haines, Director of Public Service gave an update on projects and accepted questions from Council.

Scott Fulton, Planning Director gave an update on an AEP grant that was received as well as an update on Ordinance 2018-4314.

Lenier Crawford, Park Manager gave an update on the department activities and accepted questions from Council.

Bruce Brooks, Chief of Police gave an update on the resignation of Jason Gross.

Committee Chair Reports:

Building and Grounds Committee: Lee gave an update on the recent Building and Grounds Committee Meeting and reported that the committee recommended approval of a mural at the pool.

Finance Committee: Barstow announced that due to a lack of quorum the committee did not meet.

Unfinished Business

Hickin made a motion to have the second reading of Ordinance 2018-4314. Seconded by Lee. The Clerk read the following:

ORDINANCE 2018-4314 Second Reading An ordinance to rezone properties located at 14379 East Broad Street, Parcel Number 063-146946-00.000, 14359 East Broad Street, Parcel Number 063-143604-00.000, 14305 Columbus Road, Parcel Number 063-141930-00.000, and 14271 Columbus Road, Parcel Number 063-141306-00.000, totaling 20.35 ± acres, in the City of Pataskala, from the Medium-Low Density Residential District (R-87) Zoning Classification and General Business District (GB) Zoning Classification to the General Business District (GB) Zoning Classification. Discussion: Walther asked about setbacks. Hickin had questions about fencing and other problems with the property. Barstow had problem with the application.

Barstow made a motion to table Ordinance 2018-4314. Seconded by Lee. Roll Call: Barstow, Hayes, Hickin, and Lee-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.

Barstow made a motion to have the second reading of Ordinance 2018-4315. Seconded by Lee. Hickin recused himself from this Ordinance. The Council Clerk read the following:

ORDINANCE 2018-4315 Second Reading An ordinance to rezone properties located at North End Drive, Parcel Number 064-310536-00.000, and 65 South Main Street, Parcel Number 064-310050-00.000, totaling 0.70 ± acres, in the City of Pataskala, from the Medium-High Density Residential District (R-15) Zoning Classification to the General Business District (GB) Zoning Classification.

Barstow made a motion to have the second reading of Ordinance 2018-4320. Seconded by Hickin. The Council Clerk read the following:

ORDINANCE 2018-4320 Second Reading An ordinance granting (franchise) to Licking Rural Electrification, Inc., of Newark, Ohio, its successors and assigns the right to acquire, construct, maintain, and operate in the streets, thoroughfares, alleys, bridges, and public places of the City of Pataskala, Ohio, lines for the distribution of electric energy to the City of Pataskala and its inhabitants thereof for light, heat, power and other purposes and for the transmission of the same within, through, or across the City of Pataskala.

New Business

Hickin made a motion to have the first reading of Ordinance 2018-4316. Seconded by Barstow. The Council Clerk read the following:

ORDINANCE 2018-4316 First Reading An ordinance to amend chapter 1293 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Pataskala, and repeal all other ordinances and parts of the ordinances in conflict therewith.

Hickin made a motion to approve **RESOLUTION 2018-028** a resolution authorizing and directing the City Administrator to execute a contract with Jamison Well Drilling, Inc. For the 2018 Water Well Preventative Maintenance Program. Seconded by Barstow. Roll Call: Lee, Barstow, Hayes and Hickin-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.

Hickin made a motion to approve **RESOLUTION 2018-029** a resolution authorizing and directing the City Administrator to enter into an agreement with the Licking County Health Department for citywide mosquito treatment for the calendar year 2018. Seconded by Hayes. Roll Call: Barstow, Hayes, Hickin, and Lee-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.

Lee made a motion to approve the installation of the proposed mural at the pool. Seconded by Hayes. Roll Call: Hayes, Hickin, Lee, and Barstow-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.

Additional Citizens Comments

There were no additional comments.

Committee Meeting Announcements, Scheduling Issues & General Comments

Hayes reported that 300+ kids enjoyed the pool and park today. Hayes also gave an update on this year's Story Walk and the June 9th Licking Memorial Tri-Athlon.

Hickin thanked Mick Walker for coming and telling us about the Eagle Scout project. He also expressed appreciation for the Local Economic Assistance Program grant.

Lee made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Hayes. Roll Call: Hickin, Lee, Barstow, and Hayes-yes. Mayor Compton declared the motion passed.
