

# CITY OF PATASKALA AMENDED ORDINANCE 2016-4251

Passed February 16, 2016

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016.

WHEREAS, Council previously adopted the Municipal Budget for the year ending December 31, 2016, and is authorized to amend the budget during the budget year; and

WHEREAS, Council chose not to hire a full time employee as Law Director, but instead elected to retain the services of Brian M. Zets, of the Isaac Wiles law firm, to serve as the Law Director for the City; and

WHEREAS, the original operating budget (Ord. 2015-4243), included sufficient appropriations from the various funds for this purpose, but were classified in the Salary & Related budget category instead of in the Contractual Services budget category; and

WHEREAS, the funds appropriated in the 2015 budget for Phase II of the Mink Street Improvements Project were not encumbered prior to December 31, 2015 and therefore lapsed back into the unencumbered fund balance at year-end; and

**WHEREAS**, significant expenditures will be made during 2016 for right-of-way appraisal and acquisition services; and

WHEREAS, various budget reclassifications, increases and decreases to the original operating budget have been requested; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.04 of Article V of the Charter of the City of Pataskala, the Finance Department has determined that it is necessary to make certain amendments to the 2016 budget; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(B) provides, in part, that no subdivision or taxing unit shall "make any expenditure of money unless it has been appropriated in such chapter."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO; A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS CONCURRING THERETO THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> City Council hereby authorizes an increase in the appropriations in the Court & Legal function, Contractual Services object and a decrease in the appropriations in the Court & Legal function,
