A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT TO PURCHASE TWO NEW FULLY EQUIPPED POLICE VEHICLES THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COMPETITIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has a continuing duty to the public to provide efficient and effective service delivery to the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has determined it necessary to add two police vehicles to its current fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police budgeted for the purchase of these police vehicles as part of the 2015 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into contract for the procurement of two fully equipped police vehicles for an amount not to exceed eighty thousand dollars.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon the earliest date allowed by the laws of the State of Ohio and the Charter of the City of Pataskala.


