A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE, AND REVIEW BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SALT STORAGE FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala has a duty to provide snow and ice management during inclement winter weather; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala utilizes rock salt during snow and ice management activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala's current stockpile capacity for salt is approximately 700 tons (seven hundred); and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala's desires to construct a new salt storage facility to provide additional stockpile capacity of approximately 1,500 tons (fifteen hundred); and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of the salt storage facility will be provided from the Street Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to advertise, receive, and review bids for the construction of a salt storage facility in an amount not to exceed \$120,000.

Section 2: This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
