A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH INDUSTRIAL FLUID MANAGEMENT FOR THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT NUMBER 1 IRON FILTER MEDIA AND VALVE REPLACEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Pataskala Utility Department (“the department”) provides drinking water to customers through the Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the recent Ohio Environmental Protection Agency governs regulations to meet treatment expectations to ensure the best product to the customers; and

WHEREAS, the recent Ohio Environmental Protection Agency inspection included the requirement to reinvest in the three (3) Iron Filter through media replacement; and

WHEREAS, the current filter media nearly twenty years old requires replacement; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary during this project to replace treatment operational valves that are at an age that requires replacement to ensure reliability; and

WHEREAS, the department desires to contract with Industrial Fluid Management for the media replacement (Quote #12543) and valve replacement (Quote #12544) project in an amount not to exceed dollars forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) ; and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of this project includes 2015 Capital Improvement Funds through the Water Treatment Plant Improvement Fund. This project has resulted in a supplemental to ensure sufficient capital funds for this project under the 2015 Utility Budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:



Project in an amount not to exceed forty thousand dollars (\$40,000).
