#### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S (ODOT) COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM.

**WHEREAS**, The City of Pataskala purchases salt for use on roadways as part of our ice and snow management plan during the winter months; and

**WHEREAS**, ORC Section 5513.01 (B) provides the opportunity for municipal corporations to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies and other articles.

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to participate in the ODOT Cooperative Purchasing Program in an effort to purchase road salt at the most competitive price.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:**

**Section 1:** The City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter the City of Pataskala to participate in the ODOT Winter (018-16) contract for road salt.

**Section 2:** The City Administrator is hereby authorized to agree on behalf of the City of Pataskala to be bound by all terms and conditions as the Director of Transportation prescribes.

**Section 3:** The City Administrator is hereby authorized to agree on behalf of the City of Pataskala to directly pay vendors, under each contract of ODOT in which the City of Pataskala participates, for items it receives pursuant to the contract.


**Section 4:** The City of Pataskala agrees to be responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the Cooperative Purchasing Program under ORC Section 5513.01(B). The City of Pataskala agrees to waive any claims, actions, expenses, or other damages arising out of its participation in the cooperative purchasing program which the City of Pataskala may have or claim to have against ODOT or its employees, unless such liability is the

result of negligence on the part of ODOT or its employees.

**Section 5:** This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
