RESOLUTION 2016-019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE, AND REVIEW BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE RIVER FOREST LIFT STATION UPGRADE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Utility Department provides wastewater treatment for residents through the Water Reclamation Facility; and

WHEREAS, the wastewater generated by residents are delivered from the wastewater collection system to the treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, the River Forrest Lift Station collects sewage and pumps to the treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, because the River Forest Lift Station has been in service since 1972 under the current configuration, it needs upgraded. This much needed upgrade will help ensure future reliable service; and

WHEREAS, based upon the design documents for the River Forest Rehabilitation Project and information from the Utility Department, it is reasonably anticipated that the project will cost more than the competitive bidding threshold but will not to exceed two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (**\$250,000**); and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala previously approved funding for this project as part of the 2016 Sewer Budget, designated as "SWR-15-010 River Forest Lift Station Upgrade Project".

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to advertise, receive, and review bids for the construction of the River Forest Lift Station Upgrade Project in an amount not to exceed two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (**\$250,000**). The advertisement shall be once a week for at least two weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.


Section 2: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 4: This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption, as allowed under Section 4.07(B) of the City of Pataskala Charter.
