### RESOLUTION 2017-038

#### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE, RECEIVE, AND OPEN BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW CITY POLICE STATION FACILITY**

**WHEREAS**, with Resolution 2016-054, adopted on September 6, 2016, Council for the City of Pataskala authorized and directed the City Administrator to enter into a contract with Horne & King Architects for the design of a new police station facility; and

**WHEREAS**, Horne & King's design work for the new police station facility is substantially complete; and

**WHEREAS**, because the reasonably anticipated cost to construct the new police station facility will exceed the Ohio statutory minimum amount, Section 8.02 of the City Charter requires this contract be procured via competitive bidding. The City of Pataskala, therefore, must advertise, receive, and open bids from qualified companies for the construction of the police station facility.

**WHEREAS**, Council for the City of Pataskala would like to authorize and begin the competitive bidding process.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:**

**Section 1:** The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to advertise, receive, and open bids for the construction of a new police station facility.


**Section 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.


