A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH STRAND ASSOCIATES, INC. TO COMPLETE A STORM WATER IMPROVEMENTS STUDY FOR THE GRAHAM ROAD/KYLEMORE SUBDIVISION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala has a continuing duty to maintain public storm water systems and related infrastructure within the City; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala understands and recognizes the need for flooding issues within the Kylemore Subdivision and adjacent areas along Graham Road to be resolved; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to conduct a storm water study to identify and analyze available alternative solutions to resolve the flooding and related issues; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala desires to contract with Strand Associates, Inc. for these services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract, in an amount not to exceed \$11,600, with Strand Associates, Inc. to complete a storm water improvements study for the Graham Road/Kylemore Subdivision Improvements project.

<u>Section 2:</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

<u>Section 3:</u> This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
