A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE A NEW FULLY-EQUIPPED UTILITY VEHICLE THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COMPETITIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police works hard to provide efficient and effective service to the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police believes it necessary to add a utility vehicle to its current fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police desires to purchase one (1) 2017 John Deere utility vehicle for use by the Division of Police; and

WHEREAS, this utility vehicle will be purchased through the State of Ohio Competitive Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police budgeted for the purchase of this utility vehicle as part of its 2017 budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract to purchase of a fully-equipped utility vehicle, from the State of Ohio Competitive Purchasing Program, for an amount not to exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$20,000).




