### RESOLUTION 2017-049

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH ROBERTSON CONSTRUCTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW MUNICIPAL POLICE STATION**

**WHEREAS**, on May 15, 2017, the Pataskala City Council authorized and directed the City Administrator to advertise, receive, and open bids for the construction of a new municipal police station; and

**WHEREAS**, the municipal police station construction bid opening was held on Thursday, June 29<sup>th</sup>; and

**WHEREAS**, the lowest and best bid was submitted by Robertson Construction and

**WHEREAS**, the bids submitted by Robertson Construction are:

Base bid, Contingency, Soft Costs -	\$4,459,910
Cruiser Shelter -	\$115,000

**WHEREAS**, the City Administrator recommends executing a contract with Robertson Construction for the construction of a new municipal police facility.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:**

**Section 1.** Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to enter into contract with Robertson Construction for the construction of a new municipal police station in an amount not to exceed:

Base bid, Contingency, Soft Costs -	\$4,459,910
Cruiser Shelter -	\$115,000

**Section 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.


**Section 3:** This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
