## **ORDINANCE 2017-4283**

Passed May 1, 2017

## AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A DEVELOPMENT PAYMENT IN-LIEU FUND FOR THE CITY OF PATASKALA.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala desires to provide for development payments in-lieu within the City, and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Resolution of the City of Pataskala, Section 1117.15, calls for the establishment of a Development Payment In-Lieu Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> There is established a Development Payment In-Lieu Fund, a Special Revenue Fund, in which the City Administrator, through the office of the City Finance Director, shall deposit all funds received pursuant to Section 1117.15 or any other applicable section of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Pataskala.

<u>Section 2</u>: The City Administrator is hereby authorized to administer the City of Pataskala Development Payment In-Lieu Fund and to make expenditures therefrom as deemed appropriate for, but not limited to, walkways, lighting, signage, striping, traffic control, bridges, culverts, safety features, street furniture and other related appurtenances thereto within the City.

Section 3: The City Administrator or their designee is further authorized to review and approve proposals, based upon a construction estimate, for development payments in-lieu pursuant to Section 1117.15 or any other applicable section of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Pataskala for, but not limited to, walkways, lighting, signage, striping, traffic control, bridges, culverts, safety features, street furniture and other related appurtenances thereto.

<u>Section 4:</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

<u>Section 5:</u> This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
