RESOLUTION 2018-032

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE HENRY P. THOMPSON COMPANY FOR A STANDBY LIFT STATION PUMP

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Utility Department utilizes sanitary lift stations to deliver wastewater to the treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, on occasion, these lift stations can experience mechanical failure that could result in sanitary sewer overflows; and

WHEREAS, in efforts to help reduce the likelihood of sanitary sewer overflows, the City wants to purchase a portable 1,300 gallon per minute diesel pump with automatic operation controls; and

WHEREAS, The Henry P. Thompson Company has provided a quote for the pump in an amount of Thirty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$39,962.00); and

WHEREAS, the necessary funds are available for this purchase under the 2018 Utility Budget; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala believes it is in the City's best interest to fund this purchase at this time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract in an amount of Thirty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Two Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$39,962.00), with The Henry P. Thompson Company for the purchase of a 1,300 gallon per minute diesel pump with automatic operation controls.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of

Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in

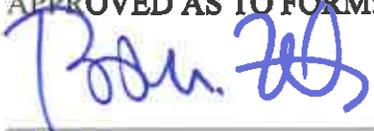
Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
