**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH BUCKEYE PUMPS INC. FOR A WATER BOOSTER STATION PUMP.**

***WHEREAS***, the City of Pataskala Utility Department provides drinking water to customers via a booster station; and

***WHEREAS***, the current booster pumps are aged and need replaced in order to continue providing additional capacity to meet system demands; and

***WHEREAS***, Buckeye Pumps Inc. provided an equipment and installation quote for a new pump in an amount of Twenty-One Thousand One Hundred Forty-Three Dollars and No Cents **(\$21,143.00)**; and

***WHEREAS***, the necessary funds are available for this purchase under the 2018 Utility Budget; and

***WHEREAS***, Council for the City of Pataskala believes it is in the City's best interest to fund this purchase and hire Buckeye Pumps Inc. to perform this work at this time.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:**

**Section 1:** Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract in an amount of Twenty-One Thousand One Hundred Forty-Three Dollars and No Cents **(\$21,143.00)**, with Buckeye Pumps Inc. for the purchase and installation of a new water booster pump.

**Section 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in
