PATASKALA COMPREHENSIVE PLAN



The City of Pataskala has initiated a process to update its Comprehensive Plan. This planning process is expected to take approximately seven months and be completed in 2018.

PLANNING 101

What a Comprehensive Plan does...

A comprehensive plan is a community's "blueprint" for future development. It is a 10 to 20 year guide for how and where Pataskala will grow, while meeting the needs of the community and efficiently using resources.

This is completed by:

- **Assessing** existing conditions throughout Pataskala.
- **Engaging** with the people who know Pataskala best, you, to understand your vision for the future.
- **Applying** best practices in advancing communities to Pataskala.

What a Comprehensive Plan does not do...

A comprehensive plan is *not* a zoning ordinance, subdivision regulation, budget, capital improvement program, or other regulatory document. However, a Comprehensive Plan is meant to provide direction for the development of those implementation tools.

What are the key elements of the Land Use Plan?

The Plan will address a range of elements that will help shape Pataskala's future, including:

- Land Use
- Housing
- Mobility
- Economic Development
- Public Utilities/Infrastructure
- Quality of Life

Who is involved in the process?

The planning process is being led and facilitated by the City and OHM Advisors, an integrated architecture, engineering, and planning firm in Columbus, Ohio. The process also includes:

- Pataskala residents and employees
- City of Pataskala staff
- Project steering committee
