A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LEBANON FORD IN LEBANON, OHIO, THROUGH THE STATE OF OHIO COMPETITIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, TO PURCHASE TWO NEW, FULLY-EQUIPPED POLICE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has a continuing duty to provide efficient and effective safety and police services to the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has determined it necessary to add to its fleet of police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police wants to purchase two new, fully-equipped 2019 Ford Interceptor SUV's for use by the Division of Police; and

WHEREAS, because these vehicles will be purchased through the State of Ohio Competitive Purchasing Program, the City of Pataskala does not have to advertise and receive competitive bids; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police's 2019 included money for this purchase.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. Council for the City of Pataskala hereby authorizes and directs the City Administrator to execute a contract with Lebanon Ford, through the State of Ohio Competitive Purchasing Program, to purchase two new, fully-equipped 2019 Ford Interceptor SUV's for use by the Division of Police for an amount not to exceed Ninety-Four Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$94,000).

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
