RESOLUTION 2019-015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AND EXECUTE A RENEWAL AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA WITH TOWN AND COUNTRY TECHNICAL SERVICE (DBA KEYTEL) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, TELECOMMUNICATION AND DESKTOP MAINTENANCE SUPPORT.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala has a significant amount of desktop computer hardware and software, file servers, local area networks, an IP phone system and other miscellaneous technology requiring ongoing maintenance and support; and

WHEREAS, as the provision of an appropriate level of technology support requires resources, experience and expertise that are not currently available with current staffing which requires the City to contract with a third-party vendor to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously retained the services of Town and Country Technical Services (doing business as Keytel) for such information technology support; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it is in its best interest to continue with Town and Country Services to provide information technology, telecommunication and desktop maintenance support.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to enter into and execute a renewal agreement with Town and Country Technical Service for the period January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2022 for a monthly fee of two thousand nine hundred eighty dollars (\$2,980), with the cost of the total 36-month contract being the sum of one hundred seven thousand two hundred eighty dollar (\$107,280).

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
