**ORDINANCE 2019-4339**

Passed May 20, 2019

**AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2019.**

*WHEREAS*, Council previously adopted the Municipal Budget for the year ending December 31, 2019 (Ord. 2018-4325), and is authorized to amend the budget during the budget year; and

*WHEREAS*, in Resolution 2018-055, City Council authorized the City Administrator to enter into a contract with Jon E. Udischas for the provision of information technology equipment and services in an amount not to exceed the sum of forty-six thousand five hundred dollars (\$46,500); and

*WHEREAS*, no purchase order for the remaining fourteen thousand dollar (\$14,000) balance was requested prior to year-end 2018 which resulted in the 2018 budget lapsing as of December 31, 2018; and

*WHEREAS*, pursuant to Section 5.04 of Article V of the Charter of the City of Pataskala, the Finance Department has determined that it is necessary to make certain amendments to the 2018 budget; and

*WHEREAS*, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(B) provides, in part, that no subdivision or taxing unit shall "make any expenditure of money unless it has been appropriated in such chapter."

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:**

Section 1: City Council hereby authorizes an increase in the appropriations in the Parks, Lands & Municipal Facilities function, Capital Outlay object in the amount of **fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000.00)** from the **Bond Improvements Fund (Fund 302)** to pay expenses associated with purchase and installation of information technology equipment for the new Police station, as follows:


Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
