**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT THE BID OF, AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH, M. P. DORY COMPANY FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE PATASKALA SAFE TRAVEL PLAN PROJECT, PHASES I AND II**

***WHEREAS***, as required by Section 8.02 of the Charter, the City of Pataskala advertised and received bids, via Resolution 2019-019, for the Pataskala Safe Travel Plan Project, Phases I and II; and

***WHEREAS***, the bid opening for this project was held on Tuesday, April 9, 2019; and

***WHEREAS***, the lowest and best bid was submitted by M. P. Dory Company in the amount of \$124,020.90, which is within the awardable threshold of 10% of the engineer's estimate; and

***WHEREAS***, Council of the City of Pataskala hereby recognize the need to enter into an agreement with the lowest and best bidder and believes M. P. Dory Company's bid meets this requirement.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:**

**Section 1:** The City Administrator is hereby authorized to accept the bid of, and execute a contract with, M. P. Dory Company for the Pataskala Safe Travel Plan Project, Phases I and II in an amount not to exceed \$124,020.90.

**Section 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

**Section 3:** This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
