### RESOLUTION 2020-029

#### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT THE BID OF, AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH, BUILDERSCAPE INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR THE LIBERTY PARK IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

*WHEREAS*, as required by Section 8.02 of the Charter, the City of Pataskala advertised and received bids for the Liberty Park Improvement Project; and

*WHEREAS*, the bid opening for this project was held on Friday, January 7, 2020; and

*WHEREAS*, the lowest and best bid was submitted by Builderscape Inc. in the amount of \$78,255.35, which is within the awardable threshold of 10% of the engineer's estimate. Builderscape Inc. also provided pricing for Alternate #1 (parking lot extension) and Alternate #2 (playground equipment purchase and installation). The total, including Alternate Bid #1 and Alternate Bid #3, is \$122,104.00; and

*WHEREAS*, Council of the City of Pataskala hereby recognize the need to enter into an agreement with the lowest and best bidder and believes Builderscape Inc.'s bid meets this requirement.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:**

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to accept the bid of, and execute a contract with, Builderscape Inc. for the Liberty Park Improvement Project, including Alternate Bid #1 and Alternate Bid #3, in an amount not to exceed \$122,104.00.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the

City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

**Section 3:** This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
