RESOLUTION 2020-044

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO REGISTER FOR CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS THROUGH THE OFFICE OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT, REQUESTING THE CITY OF PATASKALA RECEIVE ITS SHARE OF THE COUNTY CORONAVIRUS RELIEF DISTRIBUTION FUND, AND CONFIRMING THE FUNDS WILL BE EXPENDED ONLY TO COVER COSTS CONSISTENT WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 5001 OF THE CARES ACT AS DESCRIBED IN 42 U.S.C. 601(D) AND ANY APPLICABLE REGULATIONS AS ARE NECESSARY PURSUANT TO S.B. 310, NOW H.B. 481

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, 116 Public Law 136, (the CARES Act) was signed into law by President Trump on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS the Ohio General Assembly established a process for distributing funds provided by the CARES Act in Amended Substitute Senate Bill 310, now House Bill 481, of the 133rd General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, S.B. 310, now H.B. 481, requires subdivisions receiving funds, to pass a resolution affirming that funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund will be expended only to cover costs of the subdivision consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act, as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations before receiving said funds; and

WHEREAS, because the City of Pataskala will be requesting its share of funds from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund, it now wants to adopt this Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala authorizes and directs the Finance Director, or his designee, to register the City of Pataskala with the Ohio Office of Budget and Management's portal so the City can receive federal funding from the CARES Act, through S.B. 310, now H.B. 481.

Section 2: Council for the City of Pataskala affirms all funds received from the County Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund, pursuant to S.B. 310, now H.B. 481, will be expended only to cover the City's costs that are consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of the CARES Act, as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d), and any applicable regulations and guidance such that the costs:

- (a) are necessary expenditures incurred due to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19);
- (b) were not accounted for in the City of Pataskala's most recently approved budget as of March 27, 2020; and
- (c) were incurred during the period that begins March 1, 2020 and ends December 30, 2020.

Section 3: Council for the City of Pataskala, in compliance with S.B. 310, now H.B. 481, affirms it will take all necessary action to:

- (a) pay any unencumbered balance of money in the City of Pataskala Coronavirus Relief Fund to the County Treasurer, on or before October 15, 2020;
- (b) pay the balance of any money in the City of Pataskala Local Coronavirus Relief Fund to the state treasury in the manner prescribed by the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management, on or before December 28, 2020; and
- (c) provide any information related to any payments received under S.B. 310, now H.B. 481, to the Director of the Ohio Office of Budget and Management, as requested.

Section 4: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Ohio Office of Budget and Management and the County Auditor

Section 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 6: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.


