## **RESOLUTION 2020-049**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH M.P. DORY COMPANY TO COMPLETE THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AT THE BROAD STREET AND WATKINS ROAD INTERSECTION

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala maintains public roadways, intersections, and infrastructure within the City; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala believes it is necessary to improve the traffic signal at the Broad Street and Watkins Road intersection. This improvement project will include replacing the controller cabinet, wiring, and signal heads as well as adding detection for the east and west bound left turn lanes ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Public Service Director and the City Administrator want to begin construction of the Project this year; and

WHEREAS, because the cost of the Project is reasonably estimated to be less than \$50,000.00, formal competitive bidding is not required; and

WHEREAS, M.P. Dory Company, an ODOT qualified construction contractor that installs guardrail, fence, signs and traffic signals throughout the State of Ohio, submitted a fair and reasonable proposal to complete the Project in an amount not to exceed \$45,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the funds to complete the Project are available within the revised 2020 budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with M.P. Dory Company to make improvements to the traffic signal at the intersection of Broad Street and Watkins Road, including replacement of the controller cabinet, wiring, and signal heads as well as adding detection for the east and west bound left turn lanes, in an amount not to

exceed \$45,000.00.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
