

CITY OF PATASKALA ORDINANCE 2020-4373

Passed October 5, 2020

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020.

WHEREAS, Council previously adopted the Municipal Budget ("the budget") for the year ending December 31, 2020 (Ord. 2019-4353), and is authorized to amend the budget during the budget year; and

WHEREAS, the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) as adopted by the federal government provides funding to states and their political subdivisions to offset costs incurred related to the prevention and remediation of COVID19 impacts in their communities; and

WHEREAS, FFCRA funding was distributed to the individual states, who have in turn distributed the funds to the counties within each state. Licking County received their funds, and the City of Pataskala was notified that it is entitled to receive an additional approximately thirty thousand (\$30,000) to fund expenditures being currently made related to approved spending; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2020 budget did not contain appropriations for these expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the reduced level of income tax collections would result in an insufficient fund balance in the Debt Service (401) fund; and

WHEREAS, the city is required to maintain positive actual and projected fund balances in the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, instead of modifying the income tax allocation rates again, the city is requesting to supplement the fund through interfund transfers from the Street (201) fund and the Police (208) fund; and

WHEREAS, the city's Finance Director requested that city departments identify opportunities to reduce their approved 2020 budgets in order to maximize the year-end 2020 carryover fund balance leading into fiscal year 2021; and

WHEREAS, a number of other budget adjustments and reductions are identified and have been included in this legislation; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.04 of Article V of the Charter of the City of Pataskala, the Finance Department has determined that it is necessary to make certain amendments to the 2020 budget; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41(B) provides, in part, that no subdivision or taxing unit shall "make any expenditure of money unless it has been appropriated in such chapter."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED

THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1: Council hereby authorizes an increase in the appropriations in the General Government function, General Operating object in the amount of thirty thousand five hundred dollars (\$30,500.00) from the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund (Fund 224) to pay expenses associated with the payment of wages and the purchase of equipment and personal protective equipment in order to provide remote operations and a safe environment for city employees, vendors and residents, as follows:

Section 4: Council hereby authorizes a decrease in the appropriations in the Public Service function, Salary & Related object in the amount of fifty nine thousand dollars (\$59,000.00), a decrease in the Contractual Services object in the amount of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000.00), and a decrease in the Capital Outlay object in the amount of four hundred twelve thousand six hundred seventy five dollars (\$412,675.00) in the Street Fund (Fund 201) to reduce approved 2020 spending to reflect actual expenditures to date and to maximize the year-end 2020 carryover balance, as follows:

Section 5: Council hereby authorizes a decrease in the appropriations in the Public Service function, Contractual Services object in the amount of twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00), a decrease in the General Operating object in the amount of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.00), and a decrease in the Capital Outlay object in the amount of one hundred fifty two thousand dollars (\$152,000.00) in the Permissive License Tax Fund (Fund 205) to reduce approved 2020 spending to reflect actual expenditures to date and to maximize the year-end 2020 carryover balance, as follows:

Section 8: Council hereby authorizes a decrease in the appropriations in the Police function, Salary & Related object in the amount of forty thousand five hundred dollars (\$40,500.00), a decrease in the Contractual Services object in the amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), a decrease in the General Operating object in the amount of thirty five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00), and a decrease in the Capital Outlay object in the amount of sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000.00) in the Police Fund (Fund 208) to reduce approved 2020 spending to reflect actual expenditures to date and to maximize the year-end 2020 carryover balance, as follows:

Section 13: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time provided by the laws of the State of Ohio and the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
