



## CITY OF PATASKALA

### COUNCIL MEETING

May 6, 2021

The Council of the City of Pataskala met in special session on May 6, 2021 at 5:30 PM in Council Chambers, located at 621 W. Broad Street. The pledge of allegiance was given. #### **Purpose**
