ORDINANCE 2022-4418

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 929.08 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA (WATER SERVICE RATES) AND THEREBY CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A BULK WATER POINT RATE

WHEREAS, pursuant Charter Section 3.01(A) (7), Council for the City of Pataskala has the legislative power to establish the rates or charges made of customers of all municipal utilities and services; and

WHEREAS, because the Utility Department will be installing a bulk water point for the purpose of selling bulk water, Council for the City of Pataskala now needs to create and establish a Bulk Water Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED OR APPOINTED THERETO CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1: Section 929.08 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Pataskala is hereby amended to read as follows:

929.08 WATER SERVICE RATES.

The monthly rates to be charged per thousand gallons for water service for residential and commercial customers within the City's Utility Service Area shall be as follows:

| | In-Town | Out-Of-Town | Bulk Water Point |

| 2022 and 2023 | \$4.94 | \$7.41 | \$10.66 |
| 2024 and beyond | \$5.19 | \$7.78 | \$11.03 |

A minimum bill based on 3,000 gallons will be charged for monthly usage between 0 to 3,000 gallons, except for water purchased through the Bulk Water Point.

An additional monthly Capital Improvements Rate of \$3.00 per 1,000 gallons of usage will be charged for water service for residential and commercial customers within the City's Utility Service Area, except for water purchased through the Bulk Water Point.


Section 2: All other Sections and Sub-Sections set forth in Chapter 929 (Rates and Charges) shall remain unchanged, valid, in effect, and enforceable.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
