A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT TO PURCHASE A NEW POLICE K-9 AND K-9 HANDLER TRAINING PROGRAM FROM STORM DOG TACTICAL

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has a continuing duty to the public to provide efficient and effective service delivery to the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has one K-9 unit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Division of Police desires to add an additional K-9 unit; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala would like to enter into a contract with Storm Dog Tactical for a police K-9 and K-9 handler training program; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the K-9 and program is \$18,500.00; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala approved a supplemental appropriation for this purchase in 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ITS MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1. The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract, for the purchase of a police K-9 and K-9 handler training program with Storm Dog Tactical, in an amount not to exceed \$18,500.00.


