COUNCIL MEETING

August 21, 2023

The Council of the City of Pataskala met in regular session on August 21, 2023 at 7:00 PM in Council Chambers, located at 621 W. Broad Street. The pledge of allegiance was given. Roll Call: Hite, Epperson, Dandurand, Hampshire, Galik, Lee -present. Walther – absent. Mayor Michael W. Compton presiding and Brian Zets, Law Director were present.

RESOLUTION 2023-068 – A resolution authorizing and directing the City Administrator to execute an agreement to purchase two (2) new police vehicles from Jim Shorkey Chrysler in Pennsylvania and have them equipped by Parr Public Safety Equipment.

RESOLUTION 2023-069 – A resolution increasing Council Member's salaries and the Mayor's salary.

RESOLUTION 2023-070 - A resolution consenting to the Ohio Department of Transportation's project to replace the Mink Street Bridge (SFN 4563743) in the City of Pataskala.
