## **RESOLUTION 2024-020**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO PURCHASE THREE (3) NEW POLICE VEHICLES THROUGH JIM SHORKEY CHRYSLER IN PENNSYLVANIA AND HAVE THEM EQUIPPED BY PARR PUBLIC SAFETY

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pataskala Division of Police has a continuing duty to the public to provide efficient and effective service to the residents of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pataskala Division of Police believes it is necessary to add police vehicles to its current fleet; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pataskala wants to purchase three (3) new, fully equipped 2023 Dodge Durango Pursuit SUVs for use by the Division of Police; and

WHEREAS, each vehicle can be purchased through Jim Shorkey Chrysler at a price below that offered by the State of Ohio Competitive Purchasing Program and below the State of Ohio competitive bidding threshold; and

WHEREAS, the new vehicles will be equipped by Parr Public Safety; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pataskala Division of Police budgeted for the purchase of these vehicles as part of its 2024 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Jim Shorkey Chrysler in Pennsylvania to purchase three (3) new Dodge Durango Pursuit SUV police vehicles for a total amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Five Hundred One Dollars and No Cents (\$126,501.00).

Section 2: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Parr Public Safety Equipment for the installation and equipping of the three (3) new police

vehicles, described in Section 1, for a total amount not to exceed Sixty-One Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars and No Cents (\$61,499.00).

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
