## **RESOLUTION 2024-031**

Passed March 4, 2024

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TO MAKE CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO BROAD STREET

WHEREAS, the following Resolution is enacted by the City of Pataskala, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Legislative Authority/Local Public Agency or "LPA", in the matter of the stated described project; and

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of September 2022, the LPA enacted legislation proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation for the described project:

The project consists of improvements to Broad Street (S.R. 16 S.L.M. 0.00-7.55) including pavement repair, pavement planning, resurfacing, pavement markings, curb, curb ramps, curb and gutter, traffic signal upgrades, and bridge deck sealing (LIC-S.R. 16-0327, SFN 4500555), lying within the City of Pataskala; and

**WHEREAS**, the LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above-described project as follows:

The City agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of the improvement within the city limits, less the amount of Federal-Aid funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U. S. Department of Transportation.; and

WHEREAS, the share of the cost of the LPA is now estimated in the amount of Six Hundred, Ninety-Three Thousand, Two Hundred, Forty-Two and ---- 00/100 Dollars (\$693,242.00), but said estimated amount is to be adjusted in order that the LPA's ultimate share of said improvement shall correspond with said percentages of actual costs when said actual costs are determined; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above-described highway and has transmitted copies of the same to this legislative authority; and

**WHEREAS**, the LPA desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The estimated sum, of Six Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Two and ----00/100 Dollars, (\$693,242.00) is hereby appropriated for the improvement described above and the fiscal officer is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order on the treasurer for said sum upon the requisition of the Director of Transportation to pay the cost and expense of said improvement. The City of Pataskala hereby agrees to assume in the first instance, the share of the cost and expense over and above the amount to be paid from Federal funds.

Section 2: The LPA hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

<u>Section 3</u>: The LPA enters into a contract with the State, and that the **City Administrator** be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contract, providing for the payment of the LPA the sum of money set forth herein above for improving the described project.

Section 4: The LPA shall transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this Resolution.

Section 5: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision-making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 6: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
