A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MOUNT WATER DRILLING OF NEWARK OHIO FOR THE CLEANING, TESTING, AND INSPECTION OF THE TWO WELLS AT WATER TREATMENT PLANT #2.

WHEREAS, the Pataskala Utility Department (“the department”) provides drinking water treatment services for the residents of Pataskala through the Water Treatment Plant #2; and

WHEREAS, the department seeks to be proactive in maintaining critical infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the two wells at Water Treatment Plant #2 have been in service for nearly ten years; and

WHEREAS, the department desires to clean, test, and inspect the two wells at the WTP#2 well to ensure useful life of the current equipment; and

WHEREAS, the department has requested bids and identified that the appropriate well service work for the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000); and

WHEREAS, Mount Water Drilling of Newark has offered this service at cost to the city for the sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000); and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase of this equipment was included in the 2015 budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a service contract with Mount Water Drilling for the cleaning, testing, and inspection of the WTP#2 wells in an amount not to exceed the **sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000)**.

Section 2: This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
