RESOLUTION NO. 2016-054

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH HORNE & KING ARCHITECTS FOR ARCHITECTURAL AND CONSTRUCTION DESIGN OF A NEW POLICE STATION FACILITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala Council previously authorized the issuance of a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for the design of a new police station facility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Pataskala selected and ranked no fewer than three firms most qualified to provide the required professional design services. It also interviewed the top scoring firms that responded to the RFQ; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Horne & King Architects is the most qualified firm to provide the police station design services at a compensation determined in writing to be fair and reasonable to the City of Pataskala as outlined on the attached contract; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala now wants to authorize and direct the City Administrator to enter into a contract with Horne & King Architects for the police station design services; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Pataskala previously authorized funding for this services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Horne & King Architects for the police station design services in an amount not to exceed \$480,000.

Section 2: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Resolution is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereof.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
