**A RESOLUTION GIVING NOTICE OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA'S  
INTENT TO SELL, BY INTERNET AUCTION, UNEEDED AND  
SURPLUS MUNICIPAL PERSONAL PROPERTY (THREE (3)  
EQUIPMENT TRAILERS)**

*WHEREAS*, disposal of property unneeded, obsolete, or unfit for municipal purposes is governed by Chapter 123 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Pataskala and Title VII of the Ohio Revised Code; and

*WHEREAS*, Title VII of the Ohio Revised Code allows the legislative authority of a municipal corporation to sell personal property, including motor vehicles, road machinery, equipment, tools and supplies, regardless of the value, by internet auction; and

*WHEREAS*, earlier this year, Council for the City of Pataskala adopted legislation authorizing the sale, by internet auction, of unneeded, obsolete, or unfit municipal personal property, via GovDeals, Inc., at [www.govdeals.com](http://www.govdeals.com); and

*WHEREAS*, the City has three (3) unneeded equipment trailers that have been used in the past by the Pataskala Public Services Department; and

*WHEREAS*, Council for the City of Pataskala wants to sell three (3) unneeded equipment trailers, by internet auction, as allowed by Chapter 123 of the Codified Ordinances of Pataskala and Title VII of the Ohio Revised Code.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:**

Section 1: Council for the City of Pataskala hereby finds the three (3) equipment trailers as surplus and unneeded for municipal purposes.

Section 2: Pursuant to City of Pataskala Codified Ordinance Section 123.02 and R.C. 721.15(D), the City Administrator or his designee shall sell the personal property identified in Section 1 by internet auction. The City Administrator, or his designee, may establish the sales price minimum and other terms and conditions for this particular sale, including requirements for pick-up or delivery, method of payment, and sales tax.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
