## CITY OF PATASKALA

### RESOLUTION 2017-050

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF POLICE OFFICER WAGES, BENEFITS, AND OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2017 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2019.**

**WHEREAS**, after formal negotiations with the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council (“the FOP”), and upon the recommendation of the City’s Finance Director and Law Director, a collective bargaining agreement was agreed upon covering the period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been found to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Pataskala and the Pataskala Police Department to adopt such contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the terms and conditions of the proposed contract, including wages and benefits, are to be applied retroactively from January 1, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council for the City of Pataskala desires to confirm and approve the aforementioned agreement with the FOP pursuant to the provisions of ORC Chapter 4117.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** Council hereby approves the proposed contract with the Fraternal Order of Police, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit A**, and incorporated herein, for the period of time from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019.

**SECTION 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Pataskala which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the State of Ohio.

**SECTION 3:** This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
