RESOLUTION 2017-065

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CENTRAL OHIO HEALTHCARE CONSORTIUM (COHCC) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFITS.

WHEREAS, the City has a continuing duty and obligation to provide employee health insurance benefits; and

WHEREAS, the City has researched potential cost-saving opportunities, and are recommending that City join the Central Ohio Healthcare Consortium (COHCC) for the provision of such benefits; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Self-Insurance Cooperative Agreement with COHCC requires a minimum 3-year commitment by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City will realize a 2.94% reduction from its current health insurance rates, such rates to be locked-in through December 31, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT:

SECTION 1: The Administrator is authorized, and hereby directed, to enter into a contract with the Central Ohio Healthcare Consortium (COHCCC) for the provision of employee health insurance.

SECTION 2: The Administrator is authorized, and hereby directed, to execute the Central Ohio Health Care Consortium Joint Self-Insurance Agreement, a copy of which is attached and incorporated herein, as **Exhibit A**, for a term of not less than three (3) years, as well as any other required contracts or agreements related to the relationship with COHCC.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
