A RESOLUTION AMENDING SECTION 2 OF RESOLUTION 2018-040 AND THEREBY INCREASING THE COST TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL A BELT FILTER PRESS FROM MSD ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES FOR USE AT THE WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY

WHEREAS, with Resolution 2018-40, adopted on August 6, 2018, Council for the City of Pataskala authorized the emergency purchase of a BPD Industries Skid Mounted Belt Filter Press from MSD Environmental; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2018-040 was approved as an emergency purchase consist with the City's Financial and Purchasing Policy, Article 13, Section 13.01(7)(V); and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2018-040 authorized the emergency purchase in an amount not to exceed \$384,500; and

WHEREAS, since this purchase, it has been determined a skid-mounted press will not fit in the existing WRF building and instead must be permanently installed; and

WHEREAS, because it will cost an additional \$10,000 (in labor and equipment) to permanently install the belt press, Section 2 of Resolution 2018-040 must be amended to reflect the new not to exceed cost of \$394,500.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PATASKALA, COUNTY OF LICKING, STATE OF OHIO, A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS PRESENT CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: Section 2 of Resolution 2018-040, adopted on August 6, 2018, shall be amended to read as follows:

The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to make an emergency purchase of a BPD Industries Belt Filter Press from MSD Environmental Services in an amount not to exceed \$394,500.

Section 2: All other Sections of Resolution 2018-40, adopted on August 6, 2018, shall

remain unchanged and in effect.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 4: This Resolution shall become effective from and after the earliest time allowed by the Charter of the City of Pataskala.
